


The Lord GOD has spoken; who can but prophesy?"NIV "Indeed, the Sovereign LORD never does anything until he reveals his plans to his servants the prophets. The lion has roared—so who isn't frightened? The Sovereign LORD has spoken—so who can refuse to proclaim his message?" NLT

"The word of the Lord came to me saying" "Thus says the Lord"
What is the simple test for whether a prophet speaks a message from God or not? See Deuteronomy 18:20-22 What is an example of a prophecy which has passed the test? See Ezekiel 26-28
New Testament Prophets:
• Jesus e.g. Luke 21, 17 and Matthew 24
The Apostle John – the Book of Revelation
• The other Apostles – Peter and Paul in their speeches and letters e.g. 2 Peter 3
The number of the prophets:

- Help understand what is going to unfold in the future
- Call people to turn to God for direction
- Give hope
- Encourage
