Look at this comment by Jesus to a couple of followers after his resurrection:

"O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?"

'And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.' Luke 24: 25-27 ESV

What Bible passages might Jesus have referred to, when explaining prophecies about himself? Take a look at the following for some of the many he could have referred to:

Moses' message to the children of Israel c 1300 BCE: Deuteronomy 18:15

Promises made by God to Abraham c 2000 BCE: Genesis 12-22, Galatians 3:16

The prophet Nathan to King David c 1000 BCE: 2 Samuel 7:12-16

The Angel Gabriel to Mary c 4 BCE: Luke 1:31-33

Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end.

He will reign on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish and sustain it with justice and righteousness from that time and forevermore.

The zeal of the LORD of Hosts will accomplish this.'
